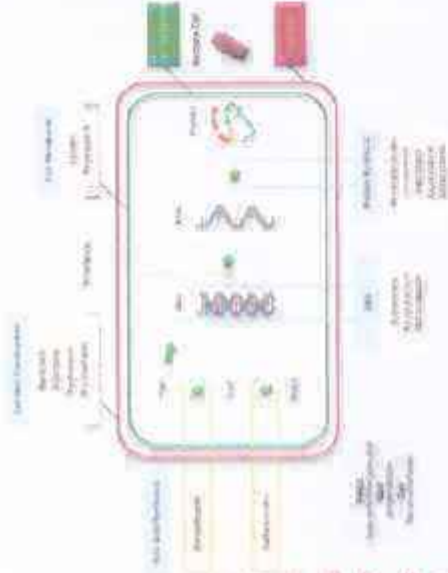

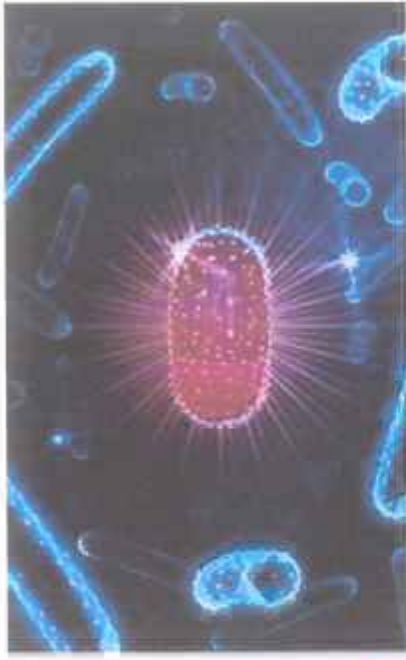

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Antibiotics are commonly classified based on their mechanism of action, chemical structure or spectrum of activity. Most target bacteria, fungi or growth processes. Those that target the bacterial cell wall or the cell membrane, or interfere with essential bacterial enzymes have bactericidal activities, killing the bacteria. Protein synthesis inhibitors are usually bacteriostatic, inhibiting further growth. Further categorization is based on their target specificity. "Narrow-spectrum" antibiotics target specific types of bacteria, such as gram-negative or gram-positive, whereas broad-spectrum antibiotics affect a wide range of bacteria. Following a 40-year lull in discovering classes of antimicrobial compounds, four new classes of antibiotics were introduced to clinical use in the late 2000s and early 2010s: cyclic lipopeptides (such as daptomycin), glycopeptides (such as teicoplanin), oxazolidinones (such as linezolid), and tricyclics.



An antibiotic is the most important type of antibacterial agent for fighting bacterial infections, and antibiotic medications are widely used in the treatment and prevention of such infections. They may either kill or inhibit the growth of bacteria. A limited number of antibiotics also possess antiparasitic activity. Antibiotics are not effective against viruses such as the ones which cause the common cold or influenza. Drugs which inhibit growth of viruses are termed antiviral drugs or antivirals. Antibiotics are also not effective against fungi. Drugs which inhibit growth of fungi are called antifungal drugs.

He said that antibiotics are powerful drugs used to treat diseases caused by bacteria. They disrupt essential processes or structures in the bacterial cell. This either kills the bacterium or slows down bacterial growth. Depending on these effects an antibiotic is said to be bactericidal or bacteriostatic. In addition to that, she said that the essential target of therapy with antibiotics is the successful treatment of individual patients with bacterial infections. The optimal clinical treatment results can only be achieved when the toxicity, selection of pathogens and development of resistance are minimized.

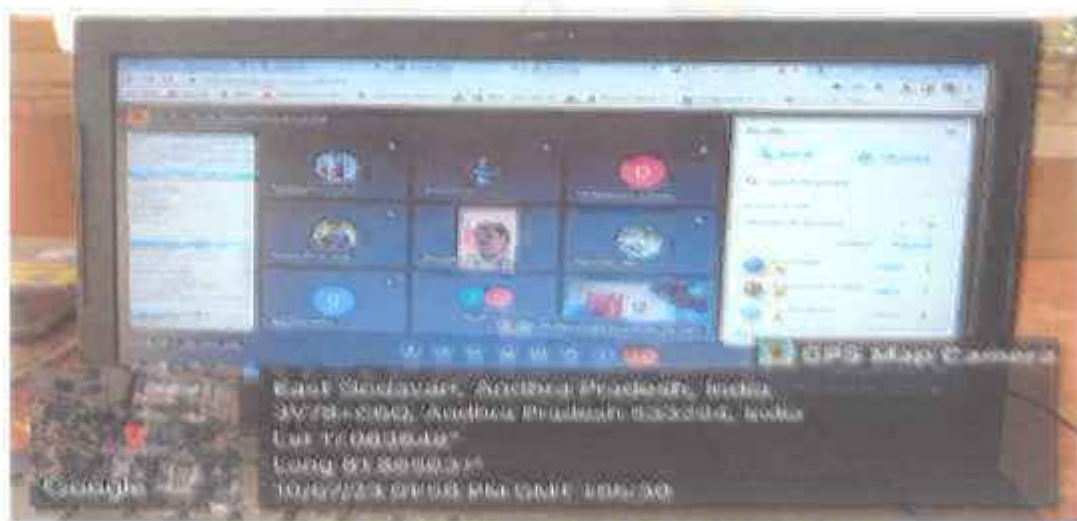


Fig. 2: Presentation on Antibiotics and its research

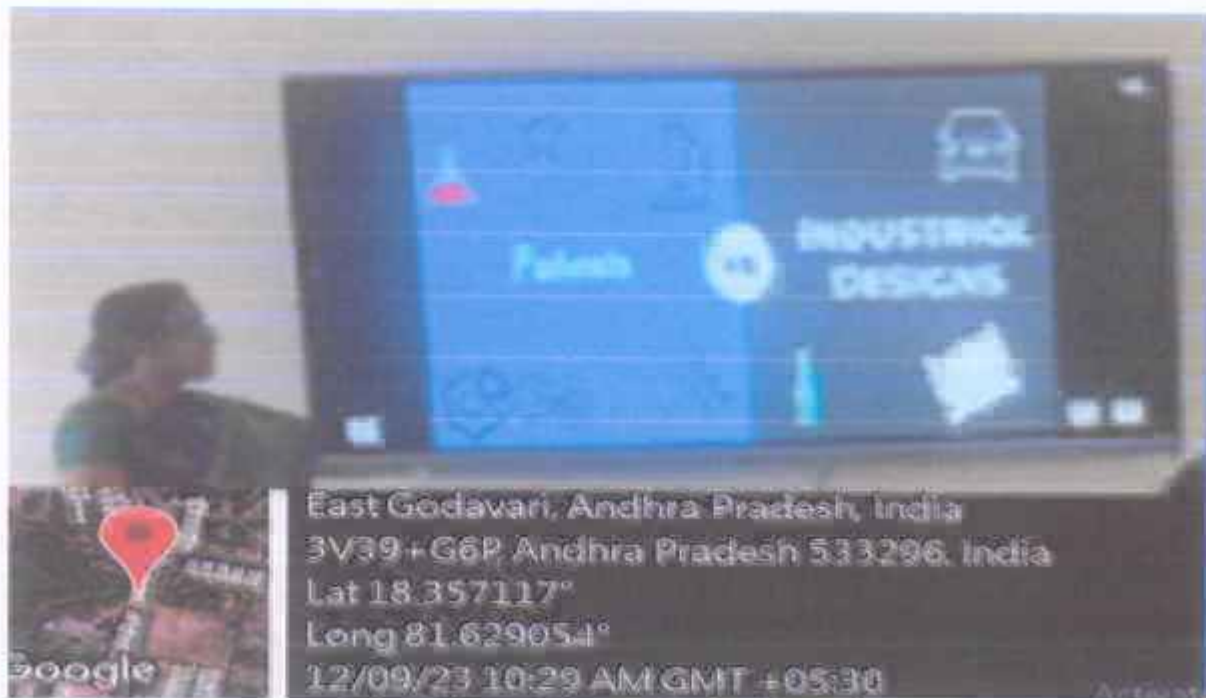


Fig. 1: Presentation on "Design Patents"

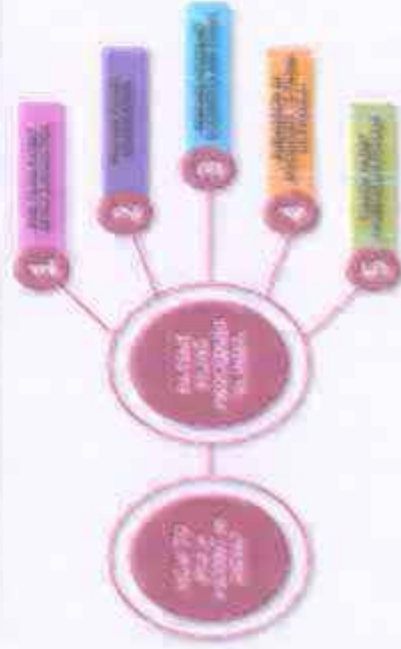

About the program:

In India, patents are governed by the Patents Act, 1970, and the Patents Rules, 2002. The Indian Patent Office, under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, administers the patent system in the country. In order to be eligible for a patent in India, an invention must be novel, involve an inventive step, and be capable of industrial application. Additionally, it should not fall under the list of non-patentable subject matter as outlined in the Patents Act, which includes things like inventions that are frivolous, inventions contrary to well-established natural laws, methods of agriculture or horticulture, and certain biological processes for the production of plants or animals. The process of obtaining a patent in India involves filing a patent application with the Indian Patent Office. The application must include a specification describing the invention and its operation or use, along with any necessary drawings or diagrams. There are provisions for both provisional and complete patent applications. After filing, the application undergoes examination by the patent office to assess the novelty and inventive step of the invention. If the application meets the criteria for patentability, a patent is granted. Otherwise, the application may be rejected, or the applicant may be required to amend the application to address objections raised during examination. In India, the term of a patent is 20 years from the date of filing the application. Patent holders in India have the exclusive right to use, manufacture, sell, or license their invention for the term of the patent. Patent infringement disputes in India are resolved through litigation in the courts.



The Indian legal system provides remedies such as injunctions, damages, and account of profits for patent infringement. India is a signatory to various international treaties related to patents, including the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) administered by the World Trade Organization (WTO). It's important to note that patent laws and procedures may change over time, so it's advisable to consult the latest regulations and seek legal advice for specific patent matters in India. During British rule, India followed the British patent system. The first legislation related to patents in India was the British Patent Law of 1856. This law allowed for the grant of patents in India for inventions that were not already patented in Great Britain. However, this law faced criticism for favoring British interests over those of Indian inventors. After gaining independence in 1947, India began developing its own intellectual property laws. The Indian Patents and Designs Act of 1911, which was a pre-independence law, continued to be in force with certain amendments. The modern patent regime in India began with the enactment of the Patents Act, 1970. This act aimed to promote indigenous innovation and development by establishing stricter criteria for patentability.

These requirements include: the invention must be new and inventive; the invention must be capable of industrial application, the invention must have inventive steps. He also said that there are three main types of patents in India:

- **Utility patents**

These patents cover new and useful inventions, processes, or improvements. They are the most common type of patent.

- **Design patents**

These patents protect the unique visual appearance or design of a product. They are only granted when the design is inseparable from the object itself.

- **Plant patents**

These patents are granted for new and distinct plant varieties that are asexually reproduced.

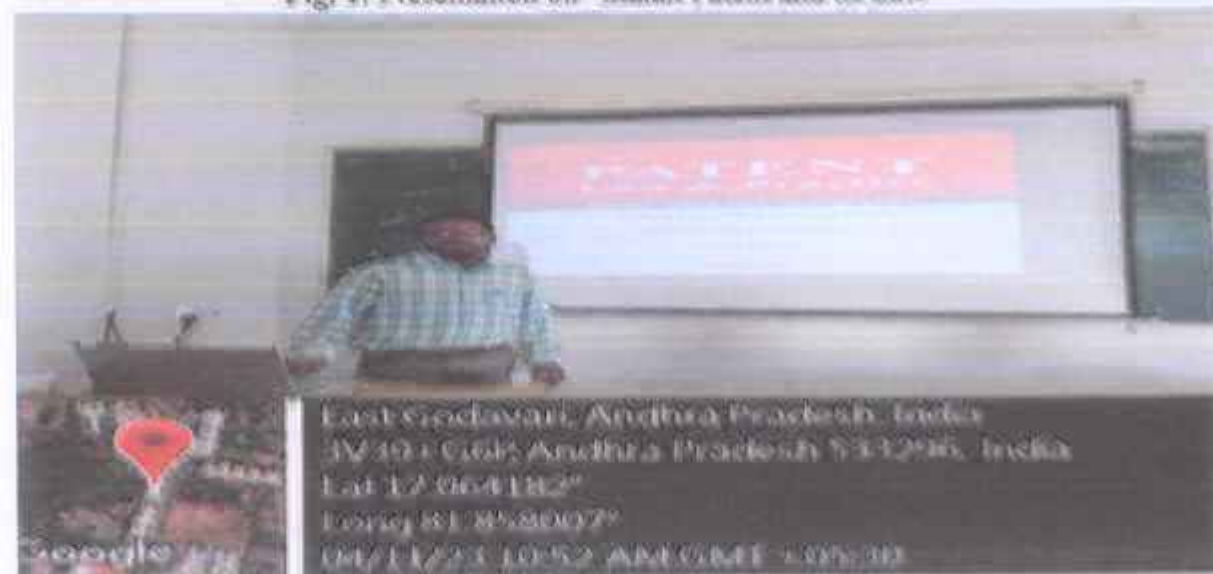

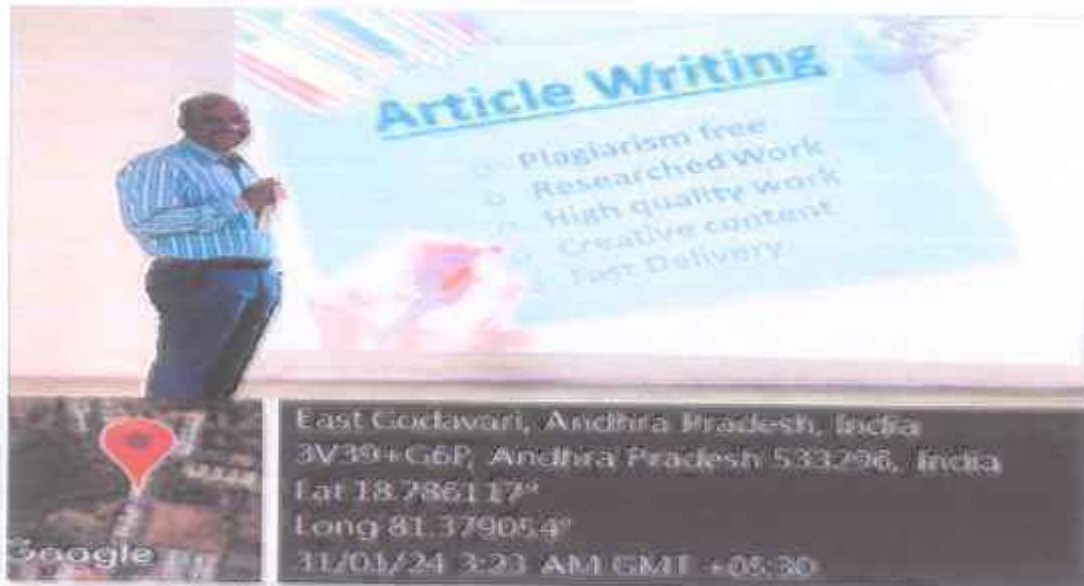


Fig. 1: Presentation on "Article writing skills for Journals"

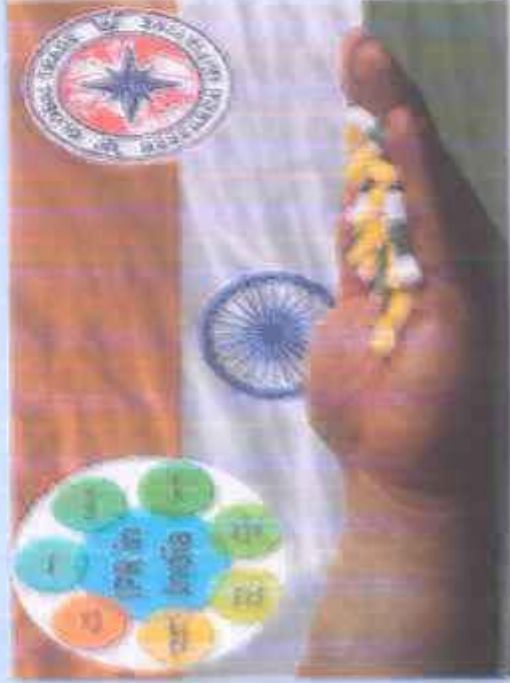

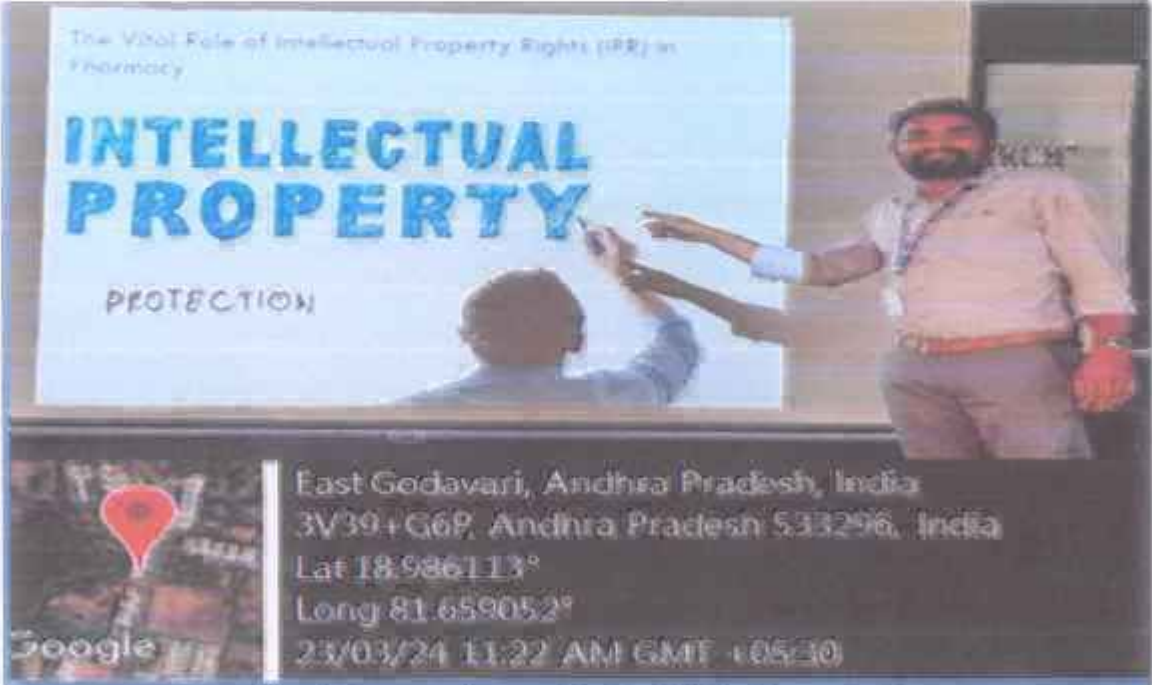


Fig. 1: Presentation on "Roll of IPR in Pharmacy"

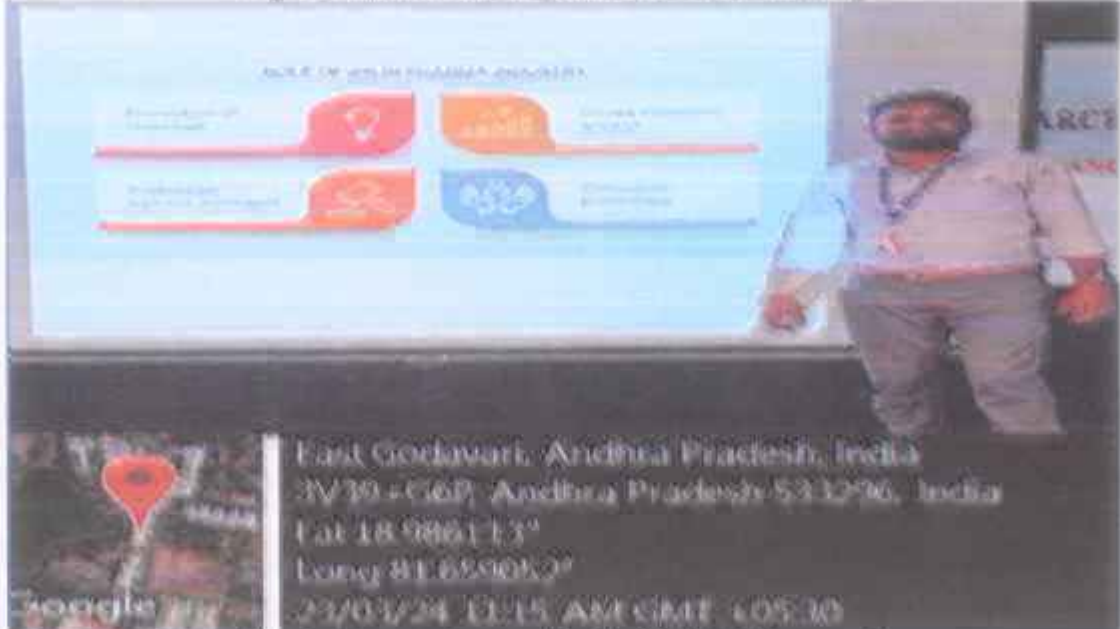


Fig. 2: Presentation on "Roll of IPR in Pharmacy"

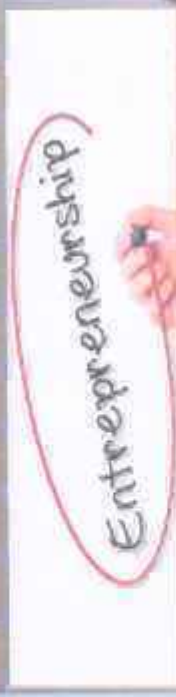

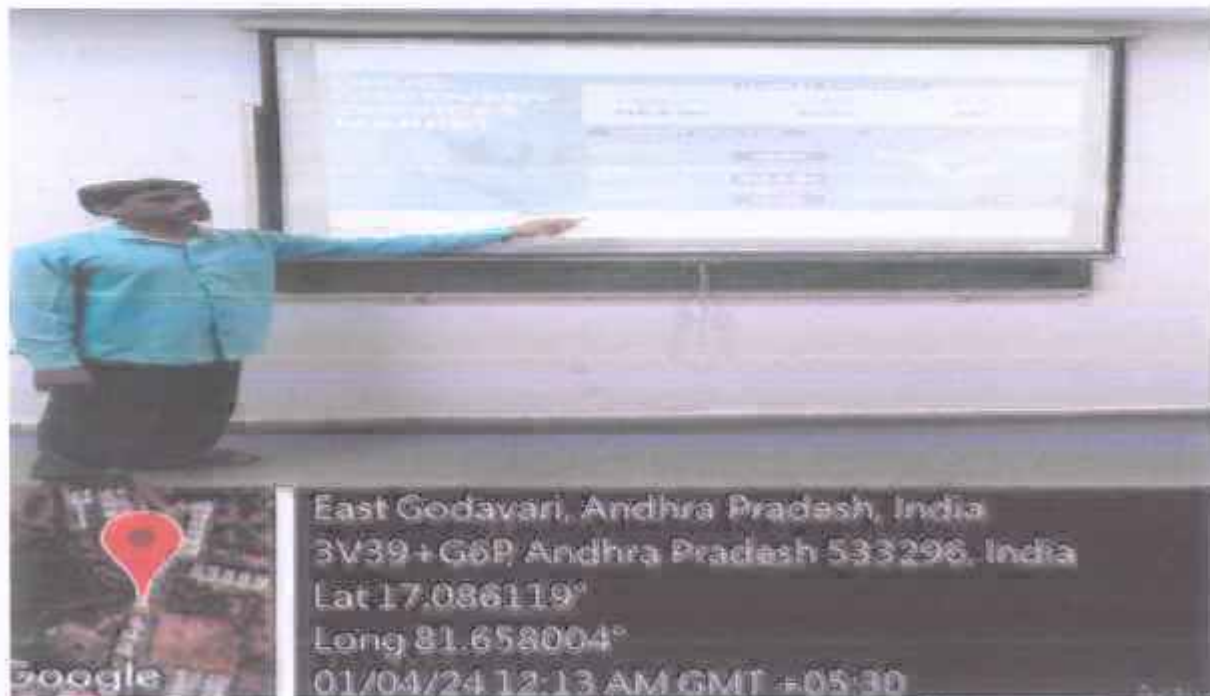


Fig. 1: Presentation on "Indian Drug Market in the Globe"

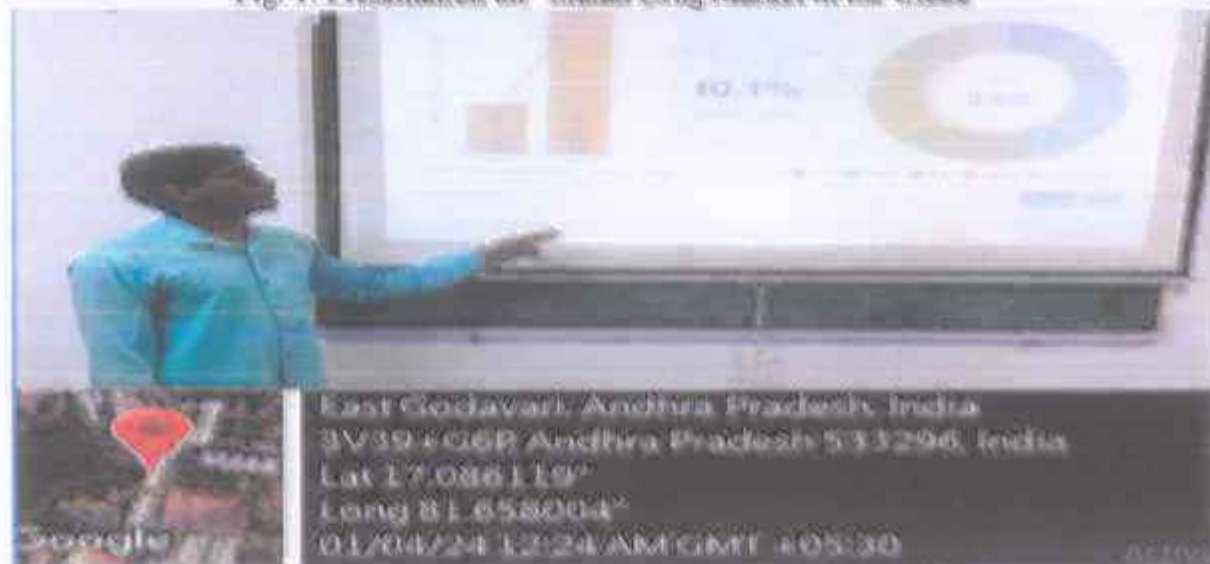


Fig. 2: Presentation on "Indian Drug Market in the Globe"

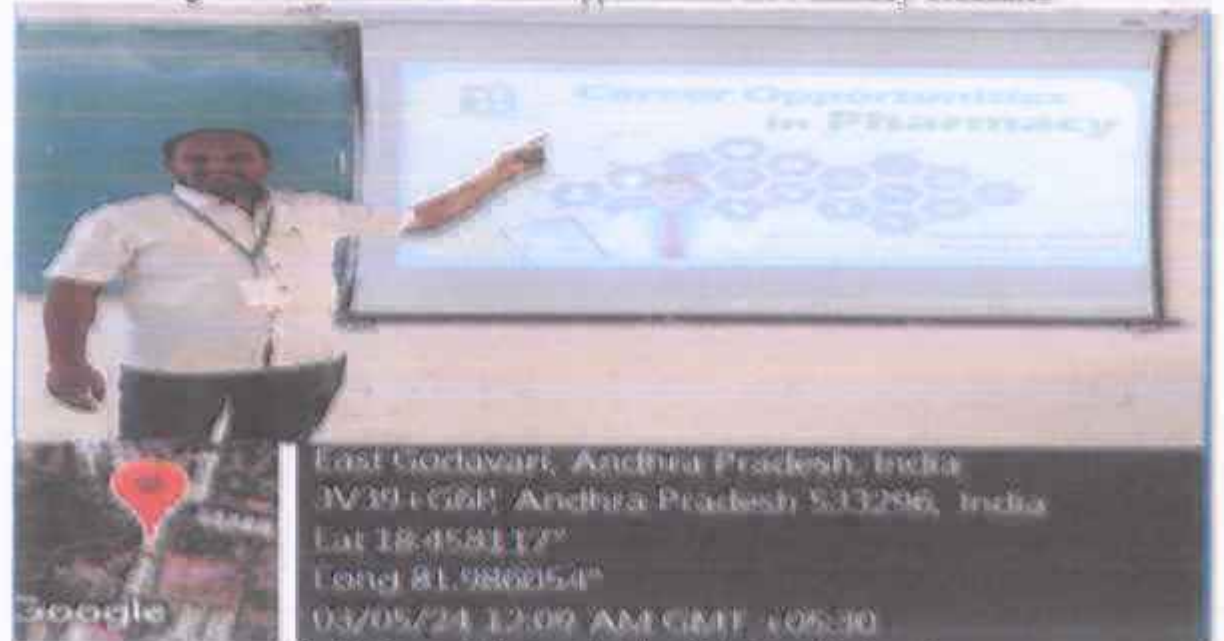


Fig. 2: Presentation on "Indian Patent and its Law"
